

Dear Residents:

Hurricane cleanup has been ongoing and is almost completed. Crawford Landscaping still has some large tree work to complete.

Trees are being staked. Stump removal will take place later.

Mulch is scheduled to be installed the week of November 13.

Power washing of the sidewalks is being scheduled for mid-November. The Association will pay for the cost to do this. Owners are responsible for power washing their driveways.

Many of the driveways need attention due to a buildup of mold. Please check your driveway to see if it needs to be cleaned.

Just as a reminder, screen and other debris should be bagged and put in trash receptacles for pickup. When we originally called Collier County Waste, we were told to notify residents to place screening by the curb for a special FEMA truck to pick up.

Unfortunately, this never happened and if screen is left on the sidewalks or the island, it will not be picked up.
